## GOVERNOR BILL RITTER

LoDo District is proud to announce that Governor Bill Ritter will be the featured speaker at the LoDo District Annual Meeting and Limelight Awards.

Bill Ritter, Jr. was elected as Colorado's 41st governor on Nov. 7, 2006. The sixth of 12 children, he was born on Sept. 6, 1956, and raised on a small farm east of Aurora.

He started working construction jobs at the age of 14 to help support his family. He worked his way through college at Colorado State University (Class of '78) and law school at the University of Colorado College of Law (Class of '81). His first job – deputy district attorney with the Denver District Attorney's Office.

In 1987, Gov. Ritter and his wife, First Lady Jeannie Ritter, left Denver to run a food distribution and nutrition center in Zambia, Africa. They returned home in 1990, and three years later Ritter was appointed as Denver's top prosecutor, a position he held until January 2005. He earned a national reputation as one of the country's most effective and innovative prosecutors, and several of his programs continue to serve as state and national models.
