A graduate of West Point, Doug is an attorney-partner at Rothberger, Johnson and Lyons. He will speak about his 2006 conquest of Mt. Everest. But that is just the warm-up. Doug’s presentation will include the story of his 2009 successful quest to become the first American man to cross the Indian Ocean in a plywood rowboat! Along with seven teammates Doug crossed 3,132 miles of roiling ocean in bad weather, enduring a capsizing, broken rudder and sweltering temperatures. 58 days and 15 hours after launching in Geraldton, Australia, Doug and his crew landed in Mauritius, an island off the coast of South Africa. You will definitely want to learn more about these harrowing journeys and Doug’s current plans to re-trace Ernest Shackleton’s legendary Antarctic voyage—but in a rowboat— followed by a traverse of the frigid and mountainous South Georgia Island.
