Denver's New Crime Mapping System

Citizens are concerned about crime, both where and when it occurs, and in response the City has built a new mapping system to keep citizens informed. This system displays an up-to-date map of individual crimes, as well as a table to show when and where the incident occurred. Searches cover 6 months, with data beginning in January 2005, and information is updated daily. Certain information is withheld to protect privacy

of victims and juveniles. The database enables users to search by specific address, neighborhood, park, school, or library.
